## **Fun Frolic Series Awards Rules**

Champion and Reserve Champion awards will be determined at the end of the Fall Frolic. Awards will be given in Combined Training, Jumpers, and Dressage.

## **Combined Tests:**

Series Awards will be given in the following CT Divisions:

Tadpole, Cross Rails, Green, Maiden, Beginner Novice, Novice, Training, Prelim

Points will be counted by rider/horse combination. Points from both shows will be totaled to determine the champion and reserve champion. In order to qualify for Series awards, the horse/rider combination must compete in the division in both shows in the series.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st place - 6

2<sup>nd</sup> place - 5

3<sup>rd</sup> place - 4

4<sup>th</sup> place - 3

5<sup>th</sup> place - 2

6<sup>th</sup> place - 1

## **Dressage:**

Series Awards will be given in the following Dressage Divisions:

Intro, Training, First, Second

Western: Basic, Intro, Level 1, Level 2, Level 3

The average of the highest 3 scores obtained in the division will be used to determine awards. One of those tests must be the highest test of that level. Scores will be counted by rider/horse combination. In order to qualify for Series awards, the horse/rider combination must compete in the division in both shows in the series.
